Classes	Description
Your Priesthood in the Marketplace Minister Sam Alexander Thursday 1/12 – 3/9/23 No class – Faith Refresher 2/9 7 p.m. – 9 p. m.	The purpose of this class is to define the priesthood and how it pertains to your daily life.
